Uniform:

Day one - Club tracksuit, club competition leotard, matching bike shorts/leggings (optional), white socks, hair pulled back neatly with competition scrunchie.

Day two- Club tracksuit, athletes have the option of wearing an optional leotard or the club leotard. If wearing bike shorts, they must match the colour, material and style of the leotard.

Please bring grips, chalk and spray bottle along from next door in a bag of your choice, along with any other items (e.g. drink bottle)

Please ensure athletes are only wear stud piercings and no other visible jewellery. Make sure any undergarments are not visible outside the neckline of your leotard and don't forget your white socks!

COMPETITION INFORMATION

The Senior Tasmanian Championships is a 2-day event for WAG gymnasts. You must compete both days. Team awards will be presented on day 1 (Saturday) and individual awards presented on day 2 (Sunday). Individual awards are awarded using scores on day one and day 2 added together.

Both days are an opportunity for level 8-10 athletes to achieve the qualifying score for a chance to make the state team for Australian Gymnastics Championships. Day 2 scores will be used as our National Clubs Carnival trial for ALP athletes.
