The Senior Tasmanian Clubs competition is a team event. It is also the first opportunity for level 8 and above athletes to qualify for National Championships for 2026.

Senior State Clubs Awards

- Ribbons – Team Apparatus to 3rd place where there are sufficient teams.
- Medals – Team All Around to 3rd place where there are sufficient teams.
